

# BURRIDGE CROSS



**Distance:** 1½ Miles



**Target Time:** 50 minutes



**Description:** Tracks, stiles, country lanes footpaths, slight incline.



**Start:** St John the Evangelist Church Tatworth (just off A358)

Walk past the telephone box and the church yard up to the main road. Veer slightly left to cross over the road to follow a track slightly uphill.

Continue up the track for approx ¼ mile passing some houses and where the track splits continue straight ahead along a sunken path and through a wooden gate.

Continue up through a field to another gate, veer right and follow the sunken path around to another gate.

Continue uphill keeping the hedgerow on your left to arrive at a country lane.



Turn right here and continue along this lane for approximately ½ mile passing a junction on your left to Cotley Ridge.

When arriving at a staggered junction turn right and immediately on the corner look out for a stile into the field.

Climb the stile to walk around the edge of the field keeping the hedgerow on your right until arriving at two stiles in the hedgerow.

Climb over the two stiles and once again keeping the hedgerow on your right walk straight ahead to another stile and down a sunken track.

At the bottom of the track turn left to arrive back at the main road.

Cross the road (take care – busy road) turning right to take the path back to the church.
