

Forton & Coombeses



Distance: 2½ miles



Target Time: 1 Hour 10 minutes



Description: Tracks, country lanes, footpaths, some slight inclines. (Take care on busy B3167 road).



Start: Lay-by opposite Perry Street Social Club.

Veer right out of the car park crossing over the road to take the left turning into Lower Coombeses.

Follow the country lane and after approx a quarter of a mile bear left at a junction to continue up the lane until it splits in two directions.

Here turn right to follow the wide muddy track to arrive at an un-bridged ford with a large house on your left.

Continue ahead along the quiet country lane to arrive at a junction in Forton.

Turn right and after the humps turn right again to follow the country lane up and past the caravan site which will be on your left.

As you drop downhill passing a pillbox on your left look out for a footpath sign on your right to take you along the drift for approximately three quarters of a mile to the B3167 road.



Turn right and with care follow the busy road down to the Golden Fleece pub.

Just before the pub take the footpath on your right through a gate following the footpath to a stile. Climb over and drop down and up steps to another stile to then arrive at a road.

Here turn left to follow the road round to arrive back at the road close to the stream and car park.
