

WATERLAKE & WREATH GREEN Tatworth



Distance: 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ miles



Target Time: 50 minutes



Description: Lanes & footpaths, in and around the town. Slight inclines.



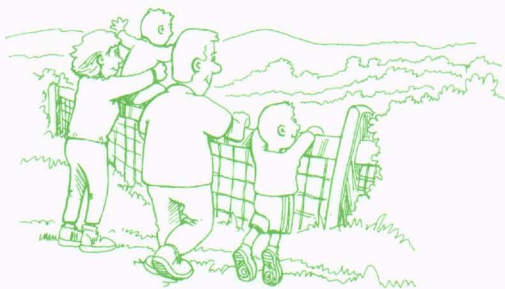
Start: Lay-by opposite Perry Street Social Club.

Leave the car park turning left along the main road. Cross the road just before the shop to take the footpath on right signposted Loveridge Lane.

Upon arriving at a metal gate on your left pass through it and follow the path over a stile.

Walk diagonally over the next field following the telegraph lines and between two oak trees pass into the next field. (If it is too muddy here walk up the side of the field until it is dry to pass through to the next field).

Walk up to the top left hand corner of the field to arrive at a metal gate and road. Continue straight ahead along the road taking the next left passing Beaufitz Place and arriving at a busy junction.



Veer left and walk along this road (care to be taken here – very busy and narrow road) before crossing the road after Gulwell Cottage to take a track uphill away from the road.

At the end of the track turn left once again along a busy road before taking another footpath on your left immediately in front of the Old Smithy.

Walk down the footpath (Caution – can be very wet) before arriving at a wide opening where you turn right over the stream and up between some houses and wire fence.

Upon arriving at a road continue straight ahead along Langdons Way until arriving at Abbey Mews.

Here pass through a large wooden kissing gate and follow the road to take the next left turning into Watermead.

At the end of the road turn left to follow the path back to the main road. Turn right to walk back to the car park.
